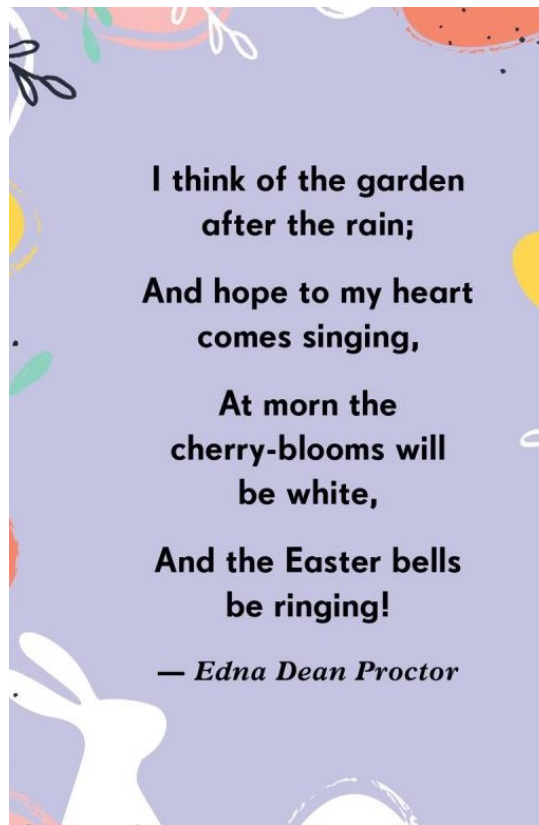

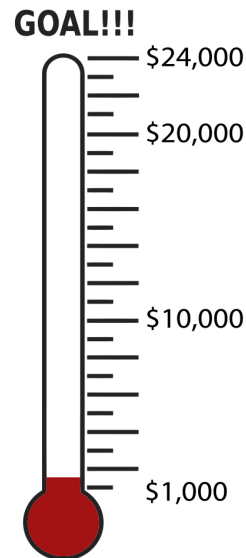
2024 IMMANUEL PAINTING PROJECT
