SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING

SUNDAY, AUGUST 28TH (Following the service)

Part of this meeting will focus on the changes being proposed to our constitution. On the next page you will find these proposed changes. Please read over them over and bring any questions you might have to the meeting on the 28th.



Proposal to modernize the Legacy Budget Process Calendar and to limit the potential of withdrawing too much due to a drop in the market from the valuation date until the liquidation date. Possibly causing the funds to be depleted more quickly.

Wording in the Constitution as of 4/26/2022: (Proposed changes in *Red*)

ByC5.05.02 Legacy Fund Structure – Four funds will be maintained, each with a designation purpose:

1. **Endowment Fund** – This fund’s purpose is to provide a long-term, sustained flow of investment gains to the other three funds described below. The principal balance (the initial balance plus any additional gifts designated for this fund) shall not be used for any purpose except to generate income that will fuel future expenditures from the other three legacy funds. Initial principal balance: \$250,000.
2. **Internal Ministry Fund** – This fund’s purpose is to assist ILC in starting new programs or expanding existing programs that expand the congregation’s ministry. Examples of items that could be supported by this fund include staff compensation, scholarships, educational materials, consulting services, etc. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the Internal Ministry’s Fund’s calculated principal balance as of June 30 (*change to September 30*) of each calendar year shall be disbursed in the following calendar year according to a properly approved Legacy Budget. Initial Funding: \$85,000.
3. **External Ministry Fund** – This fund’s purpose is to provide money for programs that are managed by organizations other than ILC. It may provide funding for items such as local, regional, or international social programs, Synod, regional, or church-wide ministries, etc. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the External Ministry Fund’s calculated balance as of June 30 (*change to September 30*) of year calendar year shall be disbursed in the following calendar year according to a properly approved Legacy Budget. Initial Funding: \$85,000.
4. **Capital Improvements Fund** – This fund’s purpose is to supplement the congregation’s support for building projects, property improvements, the purchase of major equipment, etc. Any expenditures from this fund must be matched dollar for dollar with funds from the congregation’s general operating budget, special funding appeals, or other non-legacy congregational sources. Disbursements from this fund will be determined by need, but still must be approved through the Legacy Budget process. Initial Funding: \$85,000.

ByC5.05.06 Legacy Budget Process Calendar Wording in the Constitution as of 4/26/2022:

1. June through September (*change to September through November*)— The Legacy Budget Committee holds open forum(s) to solicit input from the congregation on potential uses of the Legacy Funds.
2. August 1 (*Change to November 1*)— The Legacy Finance and Investment provides the Budget Committee with the dollar amount available for disbursement from each Legacy Fund during the following calendar year.
3. August 31 (*Change to November 30*)— The deadline for submitting written applications for Legacy Fund disbursements.
4. September (*Change to December*)— The Legacy Budget Committee works to develop its recommendations.
5. October (*Change to December*)— The Committee holds open forum(s) regarding its recommended budget for the following calendar year.
6. November (*Change to December*) — The Committee presents its recommended budget to the Congregational Council for its recommendation.
7. January — The Committee presents its budget to the Congregation for approval at the Annual Meeting.
